

Medical Case Management Services

The DeKalb County Health Department provides Medical Case Management services to HIV+ individuals and their families. Our client-centered services link individuals with health care and other available resources in order to empower people living with HIV to lead healthy and independent lives. The program is funded by the Illinois Department of Public Health, and our Case Manager is a trained, professional counselor. Any individual who is HIV+ and resides in DeKalb, Lee or Ogle County may be eligible for a variety of Case Management services.
